



HAITI – PIGNON (\$2,000)



Haiti is a Caribbean country that shares the island of Hispaniola with the Dominican Republic to its east. Though it's still recovering from a 2010 earthquake, many of Haiti's landmarks dating to the early 19th century remain intact. These include Citadelle la Ferrière, a mountaintop fortress, and the nearby ruins of Sans-Souci Palace, the baroque former royal home of King Henry I. Sowing Seeds of Joy collaborates with Hosean International Ministries (HIM Haiti), a ministry by Haitians, for Haitians. Pastor Caleb Lucien, its founder, has one purpose in mind: to transform lives by pointing people to Jesus Christ through education, life skills training, and economic growth. Haiti is waiting. Options for Travel

- Fly DFW to Orlando, Ft Lauderdale (Hotel overnight) Shuttle to Ft Pierce Fly MFI to Pignon
- Drive Van to Ft Pierce. Hotel Overnight Fly MFI to Pignon (2 extra days before departure (Leave on the 14th and return date will be evening of 24th)
- Charter Bus to Ft Pierce. No hotel stays, direct to Airport and sleep on Bus. Bus picks up on 23 and depart back to Dallas
